U.S.S. Tennessee Battleship Special Event Station

February 25-26, 2022



The U.S.S.Tennessee Battleship Memorial Museum is located on the campus of Scott High School in Huntsville and contains the largest collection of U.S.S. Tennessee (BB-43) memorabilia in the world. The ship was one of the most commended battleships in history, fighting in more battles and firing more volleys than any other ship in WWII. She was one of few ships at Pearl Harbor to return fire during the Japanese attack and was instrumental in the Pacific theatre during WWII fighting at Okinawa, Iwo Jima, Saipan, and the Philippines, just to name a few.

So why is this important? The U.S.S. Tennessee was decommissioned in February 1947 making 2022 the 75th anniversary, Would you be interested in helping out with a special event station to honor those who served on her?
