### Local and In-Person Exams

The VE (Volunteer Examiner) team has made the transition to electronic submission for testing documents. While we still only do in-person testing the applicant can choose to take a paper exam or complete their test using a computer. Forms are emailed to the applicant, ARRL and to the FCC for faster processing. The ARRL testing fee is still \$15 for adults and under the age of 18 it is only \$5. The \$35 license fee is paid directly to the FCC and with the ARRL youth program they will reimburse the youths that fee! We will work with you to schedule an exam in your area at a convenient time. No more waiting or long drives or trying to take an on-line test with multiple cameras.



Fox Hunting Workshop

April 11, 2024

On March 21, 2024, Tennessee Homeland Security District 2 will host a tabletop exercise for Public Health, Healthcare, and other similarly situated agencies focused on regional preparedness for and prevention of cyber incidents. This tabletop exercise will take place at Jubilee Banquet Facility, 6700 Jubilee Center Way, Knoxville, TN 37912 from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM and will be facilitated by CyberProtex. Let Kelly KI4JAV or Bill KF4TY know if this is of interest to you as it is geared to healthcare cyber attacks.



The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program is a nationally supported, locally implemented initiative that teaches people how to better prepare themselves for hazards that may affect their communities. CERT trains them in basic disaster response skills such as team organization, disaster medical operations, fire safety, and light search and rescue. Local CERT programs train and organize teams of volunteers to assist their families, neighbors, co-workers, and other community members during emergencies when professional responders may not be immediately available to provide assistance. Before, during, and after disasters, CERT volunteer teams perform basic response activities, including checking in on neighbors, distributing information to the public, supporting emergency operations centers, and helping to manage traffic and crowds. The ability for CERT volunteers to perform these activities frees up professional responders to focus their efforts on more complex, essential, and critical tasks. CERT volunteers also support their communities by organizing, promoting, and
