

May 9th, 2024



ARRL 10-Meter Contest Partial Results

The ARRL 10-meter contest results are starting to trickle in. We do NOT have our club score yet but have found some individual scores and rankings.

Single Operator, Phone Only with Low Power:

For area 4 call signs the top finisher had 43,200 points as a reference. Bill KF4TY finished 32nd overall (area 4) but was first in TN with 5,850 points. Kelly KI4JAV was 81st with 264 points with Ricky W4NRT at 84th with 234. Carol KJ4QFD was right there too at 85th with 216 points. Stephen was using the amplifer so he was in the high power category with 3,456 points for 2nd place in TN and 10th in area 4. Charlie W4IIC was our lone entry for the Single Operator, Mixed Mode (CW and Phone) with low power finishing first in TN with 6,656 points which was good for 22nd place in his division for area 4.

Julian W5EDQ Outstanding Achievement Award for 70 years as a licensed amateur radio operator!


Seventy years ago (April 19, 1954) Julian was assigned the call sign of WN5EDQ. One month

Thats a decent showing for our casual contesters! The top finisher overall had 190,092 points for single operator low power and use of voice only. WOW! Comparing that to the top finisher for low power CW only as they had 658,880 points. CW operators score more points and can make more contacts. Jumping to the mixed category and the overall low power top finisher had 1,211,304 points.

If we can get 10 operators within 35 miles of our club call sign of W4BSF (check your distance on QRZ) we qualify as a local club. The next step up is for 50 or less entries or if our entries are more than 35 miles but less than 250 from W4BSF.



The VE (Volunteer Examiner) team has made the transition to electronic submission for testing documents. While we still only do in-person testing the applicant can choose to take a paper exam or complete their test using a computer. Forms are emailed to the applicant, ARRL and to the FCC for faster processing. The ARRL testing fee is still \$15 for adults and under the age of 18 it is only \$5. The \$35 license fee is paid directly to the FCC and with the ARRL youth program they will reimburse the youths that fee! We will work with you to schedule an exam in your area at a convenient time. No more waiting, long drives or trying to take an on-line test with multiple cameras. We try to make it as easy as possible to take but it's up to you to pass!

Quick POTA Updates

You are probably aware that the parks in the United States now have a US prefix rather than the K we used to use. Parks in Canada are now CA rather than VE. Makes sense and a welcomed improvement.

Kelly KI4JAV and Ricky W4NRT completed a multi-state rove in the middle of April adding 15 states in 5 days and 2,804 miles. They activated: AL, MS, AR, LA, TX, OK, KS, MO, IL, IN, OH, WV, PA, MD, & VA and made at least 10 contacts in each of them. Some of our members was lucky to catch them on their trip and make a quick contact. Kelly is also on her way to a kilo (1,000 QSOs) at US-0686 Big South Fork as she is at 963 in the log.

Joe N4YLA has activated some 2FERS (a park within a park) both in Tennessee and now Georgia. He is at 5 parks for his 13 activations.

Buddy W7BSF was awarded his bronze hunter certificate for his 20th park contact.

In the Rookie Roundup, a Rookie is defined has having been first licensed in the current calendar year or the previous three calendar years, regardless of license class.

If you were licensed before the referenced period, you can also be a Rookie if you haven't made any contest contacts on the contest mode (SSB, CW, or RTTY) before the Rookie Roundup contest (if you qualify as such, send the current year in your exchange). Either of these reasons qualify you as a Rookie for just one year.

The contest covers SSB (phone or voice) which is in April while RTTY is held in August and CW is in December. While we missed our chance as a club this year, we need to plan for 2025 as we have quite a few new operators as this would be a great way of making lots of contacts. If we have any new RTTY or CW operators, it's not too late to prep for this year

Did you know that there is Chrome browser extension that will provide you with real-time notifications on your awards status such as ATNO parks, WAS and N1CC park-band slot? As a browser extension is works with the POTA.app web site and identifes if you have ever contacted a park before and if so how many times. It can also respot the activator and log your QSO directly to QRZ or select logging programs. With the right rig control program the extension will even QSY for you to the park and activator of your choice. The best part it's available without a charge. Go to POTAPlus Browser Extension for pota.app (dwestbrook.net) and follow their directions then sit back and hunt!

Special Event Stations

Contact these stations and help commemorate an historical occasion or other special event. Many special event stations provide a special QSL card or certificate.

Certificates and QSL cards: To obtain a certificate from any of the special-event stations offering them, send your QSO information along with a 9x12 inch self-addressed, stamped envelope to address listed in the announcement. To receive a special event QSL card (when offered), be sure to include a self-addressed, stamped business envelope along with your QSL card and QSO information.
