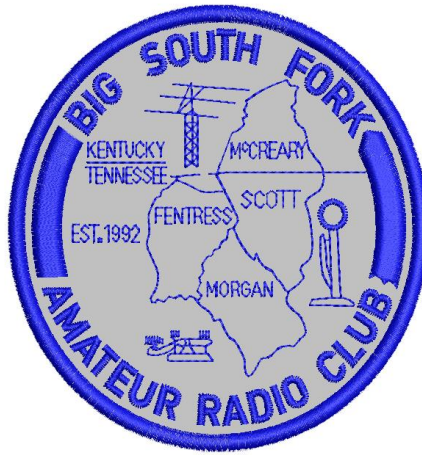

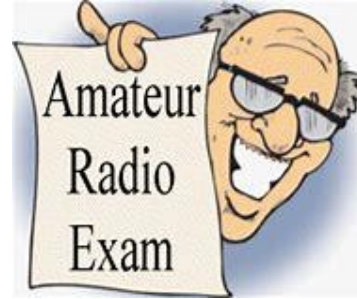
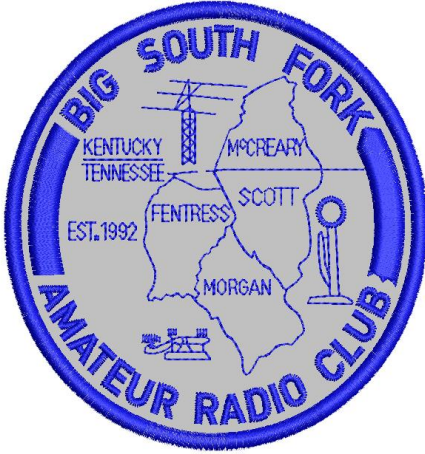

Local and In-Person Exams

The VE (Volunteer Examiner) team has made the transition to electronic submission for testing documents. While we still only do in-person testing the applicant can choose to take a paper exam or complete their test using a computer. Forms are emailed to the applicant, ARRL and to the FCC for faster processing. The ARRL testing fee is still \$15 for adults and under the age of 18 it is only \$5. The \$35 license fee is paid directly to the FCC and with the ARRL youth program they will reimburse the youths that fee! We will work with you to schedule an exam in your area at a convenient time. No more waiting, long drives or trying to take an on-line test with multiple cameras. We try to make it as easy as possible to take but it's up to you to pass!

were made. The radio winds were with us this year and the bands were in pretty good shape. Most of all, we achieved the primary goal of the TN QSO Party. Have fun!

In 2024, all participants made a total of 33,393 QSOs. CW QSOs led the way again this year, with 21,520. Phone contacts were next, with 11,736 QSOs. Thanks to a great effort from a few operators, RTTY QSOs increased this year to 128.

The Big South Fork Amateur Radio Club placed 5th with 95,211 points for Tennessee based clubs. Way to go!

A big shout out to our operators in Fentress County as they had 741 contacts! Scott County had 399 QSOs and it does not appear that Morgan had any entries. Bill KF4TY finished overall 29th in the state (5th within his category) with 261 QSOs totaling 97,743 points and had 35 TN counties. Stephen KI4NG was down the leader board a bit further with 114 QSOs resulting in 14,364 points and he made contact with 5 other counties. Joe N4YLA was mainly hunting others and managed 13 contacts for 468 points including 6 other counties.

Stephen and Joe competed in the Single OP, low power (100 watts or less), fixed location and only phone (voice). If Bill did not submit his handful of digital contacts, he would have almost come in 3rd place for low power phone contacts.

The Ciro Mazzoni STEALTH LOOP - It looks like abstract art, but it is a compact HF transmitting antenna that offers automatic tuning continuous coverage from 6.6 to 29.8 MHz when interfaced with a supported HF transceiver. It handles 125 watts and tunes to a 1.3:1 SWR. This antenna is only 54 inches long, 19.6 inches high and 10.2 inches wide and weighs only 15.4 lbs. It is made with a very rugged 60/60 aluminum alloy and powder coated in a dark green finish that is perfect for stealth operations. 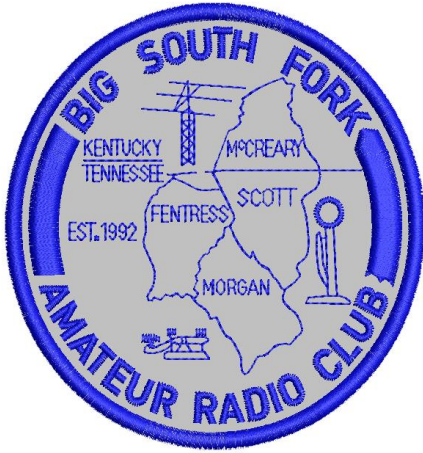
